

LLANDAFF SOCIETY COMMITTEE MEETING 27 MAY 2022

CONSIDERATION OF CARDIFF COUNCIL'S INFORMAL TENDER PROCESS FOR "FORMER BOWLING CLUB, TENNIS COURTS AND GARAGES AT LLANDAFF FIELDS"

At the meeting of the Llandaff Society Committee on 27 May 2022 it was **AGREED** that we would make the Society's support of restoration and continued use of the Bowling Green, Pavilion, Tennis Courts and ancillary buildings in Llandaff Fields known to our Ward Councillors and the new Cabinet Member for Culture, Parks and Events, Cllr Jennifer Burke-Davies.

In relation to future management of these facilities the Society requests - in line with our objectives as a Civic Society - that the Council make sure they:

- i. preserve the facilities' current low intensity impact on the park,
- ii. ensure that future uses maximise benefit to the health and well-being of people of all ages in the communities living near Llandaff Fields who can access its facilities sustainably,
- iii. reject any proposals that would only benefit limited sections of the community or reduces the range of sports catered for,
- iv. reject any proposal that allows vehicles to access this area or includes lighting , and
- v. ensure that any bid that they accept would enhance the character and ambiance of the parkland and surrounding areas rather than detract from it.

Of the bids of which we are aware for management of these facilities in Llandaff Fields the one which accords most closely with the criteria set out in i-v above is that by Strike Sports.
